

**TOPIC: CHIMNEY FIRES**

**DESCRIPTION:** The student will function as a member of an interior attack team, will extinguish a chimney fire using positive pressure ventilation, a dry chemical extinguisher, and the required hoselines in place from a fire department pumper to the satisfaction of the instructor.
